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NOTIFICATION

No. H. 11018/6/2019-REV/Pt, the 23rd November, 2021. Whereas instances have come to the Notice of the Government that there are numbers of allotment of passes already approved by the Government which are not collected by the allottees.

In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 128 and 129 of the Mizoram (Land Revenue) Act, 2013, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to issue the following orders with immediate effect and until further order :

1. The Revenue Officer who maintains the land record shall convey the approval of the Government to the person(s) who is allotted land prior to 18.11.2019 in writing in the form of letter or in electronic form or through a local newspaper informing him to collect the pass or if unavoidable circumstances prevails preventing the allottee to collect the pass to inform the same to Revenue Officer within 90 days from the date of issue of intimation failing which the approval shall be withdrawn.
2. If the allottee, instead of collecting the pass submits within a stipulated period a written request to extend the 90 days period due to sufficient reasons beyond his control, the Revenue Officer, on being satisfied that such reasonable ground exist may, by issuing a second written notice, give him a further period not exceeding 30 days.
3. After lapse a stipulating period the Revenue Officer shall submit details of allotment of land which are not collected by the allottee to the Government for withdrawal of allotment.
